

Hiding Lines from Printing

Set-up on the NAV Green Screen Menu

The option can be set at the global level (NAV 1), the authority class level (NAV 2) or at the user level (NAV 5). The process for accessing and activating the new option is essentially the same for all three levels of access. In this example, access is being granted at the user level (NAV 5).

- Select a user by entering a “W” in their **Opt** field (this step is not performed in NAV 1 and 2).
- Enter an “A” for **Order Management**.
