

# Dancik Open-WebService Reference

## Function ID/Path : /ap/apTransferPayables

This function will process the transference of cash between two different accounts.

### Inputs :

Variable	Type	Req?	Description
apFromCompany	numeric(1)	Y	The Company number to transfer from.
apFromVendorCode	string(1)	Y	The Vendor Code (V, M, S).
apFromVendor	string(6)	Y	The Vendor to Transfer From.
apFromInvoiceDate	numeric(6)	Y	The Date to transfer from.
apFromVoucher	numeric(6)	Y	Voucher # to transfer from.
apFromLine	numeric(4)	Y	The Line # to transfer from..
apToCompany	numeric(1)	Y	Company to Transfer to.
apToVendorCode	string(1)		Vendor code to transfer to.
apToVendor	string(6)	Y	Vendor Number to transfer to.
apToOverrideInvDate	numeric(6)	N	Vendor Override Date.
